#### Property Management Report - Since Annual Meeting, January 17, 2018

- 1) Holiday website updated with various revisions
- 2) Project: Increasing City water budgets for the irrigation water
  - RPM met with the City and Native Edge onsite and went over irrigated areas
  - Three areas are under review for a water budget increase:
    - Outlot E (Park) Native Edge and City are working together regarding the exact square footage allocated to Holiday's irrigation budget.
    - 1450 Yaupon RPM is working with Native Edge and City to have this land reallocated to Holiday's budget - it is currently allocated to two other properties.
    - Outlot A (along 28<sup>th</sup> St.) RPM is working with City to have this area reallocated to Holiday – it is currently allocated to the Dept. of Transportation Division.

# **New Business**

- 1) Tree care 2018 Davey Tree Proposal
  - Proposal \$4,059 includes EAB (done every other year)
  - Budget \$4,000
- 2) Adding electricity to the Park
  - Desirable for: Movies in the Park, Party in the Park, and sprinkler valves & clocks (currently battery-operated)
  - Native Edge says part of the reason the valves are malfunctioning, leading to water leaks/high water bills, is because the batteries fail, plus the battery-operated valves are not as reliable as the hard-wired kind.
    - Options:
      - Increase monthly site visits (\$\$\$)
      - Change batteries once a month (\$)

- 3) Movies in the Park AJ will be continuing to choose movies and get them organized.
  - will need to hire the production group to actually run movies
  - Ronnie applying for a grant for the screen
  - Meg and Katharine to reach out to homeowner who was interested in volunteering time to help with movie program.
- 4) Holiday Party in the Park
