### **Management Report**

- 1. Verifed funds rec'd for sign rental; sent ledger to Aaron **Ronnie** to tell Tracey who should get the money once she has located the funds.
- 2. Snow removal for Habitat for Humanity discussed w/contact; info logged for next season **Aaron** to talk to Habitat about the possibility to have the HOA take over/buy the two vacant lots at (e.g. for community gardens).
- 3. Spring clean up completed

### **Old Business**

- 1. Sidewalks HOA responsibility: Adjacent home owners are responsible for snow removal and maintenance (see Boulder Revised Code Chapter 8-2)
- 2. Porchfront Homes/Sanitas Terrace water use. Keep this item open: **Tracey** to present bill over \$124.50 from Green Spaces to Porchfront properties to re-plumb the irrigation.

#### **Kiosk Update**

1. Old notes: "Dave showed some pricing (email). Ronnie showed a custom option (also email). Dave and Ronnie to discuss further and come up with a final proposal for Board to approve then (budget is \$800)"

New notes from today's meeting:

- a. Ronnie and Buffy showed a layout for the location of the new kiosk. Proposed is a location on the East side. **Aaron** did close the loop with P&R Boulder. They are ok with our kiosk plans
- b. **Dave** is working with Namaste to see if we can get a solar installation for the kiosk lighting.
- **c**. Buffy will continue to work on construction drawings with help from **Ronnie**, so that HOA Board can get bids from other vendors.
- 3. HB 1359 plus 1-8 policies attorney (Orten, Cavenaugh, Richmond & Holmes) price to do 9 policies \$990 –. **Board approved to move forward with this work. Tracey** to check if this price includes review and small revisions by the board.
- 4. Tracey emailed final 2010 budget sheet out to all board members on 3/10/2010.

#### **New Business**

1. Tree pruning and/or health treatments to 36 drainage trees? Deep root fertilization 123 trees = \$650 Davey Tree - **Tracey** to check with Augustine.

#### In Process

1. The Crescent – dues charge back. – **Tracey** to work the difference of ~\$7,000 with the Crescent property manager (Jan Stolpe).

- 1. Downtown Boulder seems to have a combo-ECO pass for a commercial/residential mix whereas Holiday has only a NECO pass currently excluding the commercial owners in the neighborhood (who also pay HOA dues, though). HOA Board to investigate Michael to talk to Andrea Robbins.
