Topics Covered in this Presentation

- An Eco Pass is an annual transit pass that allows for <u>free</u>, <u>unlimited</u> access to all Local, Express, and Regional bus and light rail routes across the RTD network in Boulder and the Denver metropolitan area.
- For example, the SKIP and Route #204 bus routes serve our Holiday neighborhood.
- A trip to DIA on the AB bus route, aka the SkyRide, is only \$2.50 each way with your Holiday Eco Pass.

What is the Holiday Eco Pass Program?

If bought at retail from RTD, an Eco Pass would cost \$176 per month or \$1,936 per year.

- The Eco Pass program is one of the largest items on the Holiday
 Master HOA budget
- It currently costs about \$21,000 per year

How much does it cost the Holiday HOA?

The Holiday Eco Pass is paid for by your monthly Holiday Master HOA fee (currently ~\$20/month, per household)

How is it paid for?

- The Holiday Eco Pass program is for residents of the Holiday Neighborhood only - see map at http://www.holidayneighborhood.com/ map.php for the geographic boundaries of the Holiday Neighborhood
- There is no limit to the number of Eco Passes per household

Who can use it?

If bought at retail from RTD, these 390 Eco Passes would cost \$755,040 per year.

RTD still has no usage data for the Smart Cards, yet! How much is it used?

- During the year, send email to holidayecopass@comcast.net to get automated email with latest instructions on where, when and how to get help with your Holiday Eco Pass
- Again, this program is available only to residents of the Holiday Neighborhood

How do I get a Holiday Eco Pass?

- Your Holiday Eco Pass is valid for one calendar year (Jan - Dec) at the end of which you will need to go to one of the Holiday Eco Pass Renewal sessions (see previous slide) to get your pass renewed for the next calendar year
- Residents who do <u>not get their</u>
 Holiday Eco Passes renewed will have their cards **deactivated**.
